# **Standard Mileage Rates**

The standard mileage rates are as follows:

- 54.5 cents per mile for business miles driven
- 18 cents per mile driven for medical or moving purposes
- 14 cents per mile driven in service of charitable organizations

## Minimum Wage

The minimum wage rate is \$7.25.

## **Social Security Tax**

The maximum amount of earnings subject to Social Security Tax (taxable maximum) is \$128,400.

### **Annual Gift Exclusion**

The annual gift exclusion is \$15,000.

# Health Savings Accounts (HSA)

The annual deductible contribution for HSAs is \$3,450 for individuals and \$6,900 for families. For those aged 55-64 and not enrolled in Medicare, there is an additional contribution of \$1,000.

## American Opportunity Credit (formerly Hope Scholarship Credit)

The maximum credit is \$2,500 for qualified tuition and related expenses.

## 401(k) and 403(b) Contributions

The maximum amount that can be contributed to your 401(k) or 403(b) Plan is \$18,500. For those aged 50 and over, the maximum amount is \$24,500.

### **Simple IRA Contributions**

The amount an employee can contribute to a Simple IRA cannot exceed \$12,500. For those aged 50 and over, the maximum amount is \$15,500.

#### **IRA Contributions**

The most that an individual can contribute to a <u>traditional IRA</u> or <u>Roth IRA</u> generally is the smaller of:

- \$5,500 (\$6,500 if the individual is age 50 or older), or
- the individual's taxable compensation for the year
